



# BIBLE TRIVIA

## General Information

1. The girls are only required to learn the answers. Scripture Reference is provided for anyone who would like to validate the accuracy of the answers but is not required for the competition (unless specified in question/section).
2. All girls who wish to engage in Bible trivia are welcome to participate.
3. Each church should confirm the age/school grade of each participant. This means that if clubs are combined, the participant should be appropriate for age/school grades. (If Daisies and Prims are together in one class the Daisy participant must be in Kindergarten and the Prim participant should be a 1st or 2nd grader).
4. The churches are not required to have a participant for each club to participate. This means that if the church only has a Daisy, she is able to participate even if the church does not have participants from any other club.
5. Girls should also memorize the Girls Ministry Distinctives and their Club Distinctives. This information will be used for tie breakers.
6. Handheld buzzers will be used during competition to identify the first participant to respond.

## Instructions for Bible Trivia:

- Girls will compete per their club level.
- There will be 8 girls participating at a time.
- The eight girls will compete against each other. The trivia question will be asked in its entirety. After the question is fully read\*, the first girl to buzz in must answer the question.
  - ✓ If the girl answers **correctly** she wins a point.
  - ✓ If the girl answers **incorrectly** no point is granted.
- **ELIMINATION ROUNDS:** Each group of 8 will continue to compete until 9\* questions are asked. The girl with the most points wins that round and the remainder 7 are eliminated.
  - The Elimination Rounds will continue until all girls have an opportunity to compete. The last group in the Elimination Round most likely be less than 8 participants. If there is a tie in the **last group for the winning spot** after the 9\*\* questions are asked, there will be a tie breaker question for those participants only that are tied. The winner to continue to the Semi-final round is the participant that answers correctly.

**NOTE:** If there is a **CLUB** that has **8 or less total participants**, there will be NO Elimination Round and they will immediately enter the FINAL ROUND. This group will be judged according to the most questions answered correctly.

- **SEMI-FINAL ROUNDS:** Once the Elimination Rounds are completed, they enter into the SEMI-FINAL round. Same process and rules as the Elimination Rounds. Only 8 qualified winners will move to the Final Round.

**NOTE:** Depending on how many participants remain from the Elimination Rounds, there can be more than one winner per group to move on the Final Round.

**e.g.** 19 participants qualified for the Semi-Final Round; there will be 1 group of 7 participants and 2 groups of 6 participants. From the group of 7, the top 4 participants with the most questions answered at the end of their round will move to the Final round. From the group of 6, the top 2 participants with the most questions answered at the end of their round will move to the Final round.

- **FINAL ROUNDS:** The last eight finalists will be united to compete in the final round. There will be 25\*\* questions asked. At the end of the round, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place will be determined according to points earned.

**NOTE:** If at the end of the round, there is a tie for any of **the winning spot** after all the questions are asked, there will be a tie breaker question for those participants only that are tied.

*\*If there is a non-English speaker in the group, the question will be read first in Spanish and then in English; otherwise, the question will be read in English only.*

*\*\*Total questions are subject to change and is at the MC's discretion.*
